PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Andrew Murdoch, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Bermuda.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 48(1) of the Constitution of Bermuda that each session of the Legislature shall be held in such place and shall commence at such time as the Governor may appoint by proclamation published in the Gazette:

AND WHEREAS the Legislature was dissolved on the 8th day of January, two thousand and twenty-five:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Bermuda, in accordance with the advice which I have received from the Premier, DO HEREBY APPOINT that, at the next session of the Legislature, the Senate shall meet in the Cabinet Building in the City of Hamilton and the House of Assembly shall meet on the Fourth Floor of Veritas Place, 65 Court Street in the City of Hamilton;

AND I DO FURTHER APPOINT that the next session of the Legislature shall commence at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, the 14th day of March, two thousand and twenty-five.
