Scope Clarifications

The following addendum supersedes information contained in the solicitation document issued for this procurement to the extent referenced. This Addendum forms part of the solicitation documents and will be subject to all the conditions set out in the contract conditions.

RFQ No. 2025-004Q-MPQ Maintenance and Servicing of Dogi Pot Stations

1. In Schedule 2 statement of work, 1.6. the installation of new Dogi Pots and replacement of those in poor condition. Are those new and replacement stations provided by Parks Dept?
 - a. **Yes, Department of Parks provides all the necessities for Dogi Pots, but we will need two months' notice from the contractor when they are getting low on supplies. The thing to note is that they will need to have space to store the materials we already have.**
2. In Schedule 2 statement of work, The Government agrees: 2.2. To allow for the use of a Dept of Parks truck to service the Dogi Pot stations. Are we able to provide our own van(with fuel allowance) for the work or do we have to use a Parks Vehicle on Parks Land? If so what size is vehicle? Light , intermediate or Heavy?
 - a. **It is confirmed that contractors are required to use their own vehicle for the execution of this contract. The previous reference suggesting otherwise was included in error and should be disregarded.**
3. Will the Tynes Bay dumping fees be waived.
 - a. **Please be advised that all Tyne's Bay tipping fees are to be covered by the contractor and must be included in the submitted bid pricing. The current minimum tipping fee is \$12.00 per day. Additionally, the successful bidder will be required to have their vehicle weighed at Tyne's Bay prior to the commencement of the contract in order to establish a baseline weight for accurate tracking and billing purposes**
4. If a new bin is to be installed, will we be able to charge a one time installation cost.
 - a. **The cost of installation should be incorporated into the contractor's monthly fee. For context, the number of new installations typically does not exceed five per year. Additionally, the cost of any necessary repairs to the bins or the straightening of poles should also be included in the monthly fee.**
5. Are we able to have a detailed location map of Dog Pot valets that need servicing?
 - a. **At this time, a detailed location map will not be available prior to the submission date. However, general location information will be provided below to assist with planning and initial servicing.**
