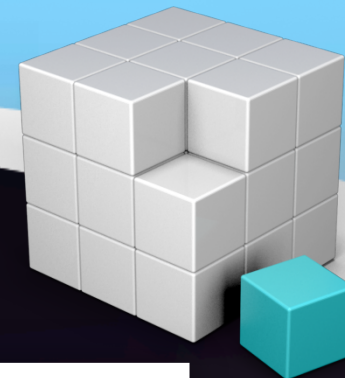


BRIEF HISTORY

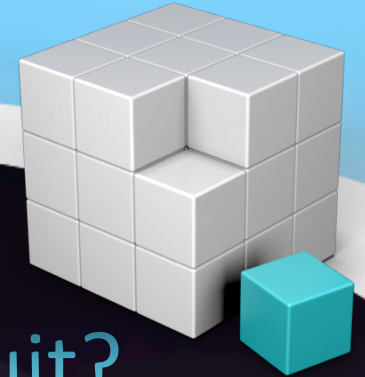
- Counseling sessions/Group Sessions

 - Maintenance and Support

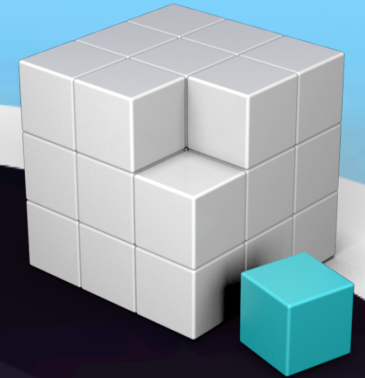
MARIJUANA PITFALL



Why is marijuana the hardest to quit?

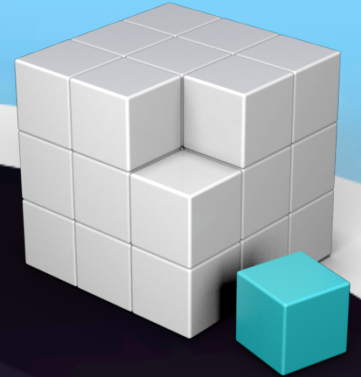
- Community acceptance/tolerance

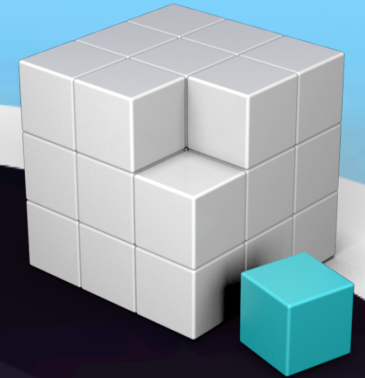
